### **Learn to Swim Programme**

The Mauritius Sports Council, a parastatal body operating under the aegis of the Ministry of Youth Empowerment, Sports and Recreation, is inviting professionals in the field of sports, fitness and physical activity, interested to serve as ‘**Part Time Coach – Learn to Swim**’ under Active Mauritius, **on a contractual basis, for a period of 1 year.**

#### **Qualifications**

- *Minimum SC/GCE O’ Level;*
- *Level 1 Certificate in Sports Coaching with specialisation in swimming awarded by a recognised institution **or** having a swimming background/professional swimmer **or** experience in swimming;*
- *Ability to swim 200 m freestyle, 50 m backstroke and 50 m breaststroke with proper techniques (Practical test will be conducted);*
- *A Certificate in Life Saving from the Royal Life Saving Society **or** a Certificate in Swimming Coaching and Life Saving awarded by the Ministry of Youth Empowerment, Sports and Recreation.*

**Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.**

#### **Duties**

- To plan, organise and deliver swimming lessons and sessions appropriate to the level of children;
- To be a positive role model, creating a positive and fun environment to motivate and encourage children to participate in swimming;
- To manage all swimming sessions preparation, including equipment set-up;
- To enforce pool safety rules and ground rules for each swim session;
- To closely monitor pupils to prevent accidents and injuries;
- To assess, evaluate and record children’s ability on criteria’s levels set;
- To ensure safe provision of all equipment and that they are used correctly;
- To ensure that the swimming pool and locker rooms are kept clean and tidy and equipment are well maintained;
- To attend meetings, workshops, briefing session as and when required;
- To perform administrative tasks, such as attendance, filling of swimming attendance card and completing other tasks related to your duties as required;
- To abide by a code of conduct and carry out duties in accordance with the policies of this Council;
- To report to the Coordinator;
- To report to the Managing Secretary as and when required;
- Any additional duties deemed necessary for ensuring an effective and efficient running of the swimming programme.
