SESSIONAL

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered as **'SESSIONAL LIFEGUARD for LEARN TO SWIM PROGRAMME** by the Mauritius Sports Council, a statutory body under the aegis of the Ministry of Youth and Sports.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates should not have reached their **65th birthday** by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. REQUIRED QUALIFICATION

- A. A minimum Certificate in Primary Education.**
- B. A qualification in Life Saving from the Royal Life Saving Society or any other recognized institution.**
- C. Valid first aid with CPR certification**

Candidates should have:

- i. Proven experience in lifeguarding
- ii. possess good interpersonal and communication skills;
- iii. inspire confidence and motivate members.
- iv. be physically fit.
- v. be punctual and well-organised;
- vi. possess a clean character certificate.
- vii. be able to work flexible hours, including weekends; and
- viii. Selected candidates are expected to pass a practical life saving test and a physical fitness test.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

IV. DUTIES

- a) Maintain constant surveillance of in the swimming pool.
- b) Responding to emergencies and rescuing participants in danger of drowning.
- c) Responsible for preventing injuries by minimizing or eliminating hazardous situations and potential dangers before they happen.
- d) Provide emergency care and treatment as required until the arrival of emergency medical services.
- e) Present professional appearance and attitude always and maintain a high standard of customer service.
- f) Perform various maintenance duties as directed to maintain and clean the facility.
- g) To apply and remove the thermal pool blankets as per schedule.
- h) Prepare and maintains appropriate activity reports.
- i) Perform miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned.

- j) Monitoring designated areas to recognize signs of danger.
- k) Warning participants regarding unsafe situations.
- l) Maintaining order in swimming areas, crowd control and patron safety.
- m) Maintaining cleanliness and orderliness of all areas.
- n) Perform any other assigned cognate duties as required by the management.

NOTE

- **Upon selection, candidates will be required to submit a character certificate.**
- **Upon selection candidates not processing a valid First aid with CPR certification will need go through the training at their own cost.**
- **A contract may be terminated at any time in the event of poor performance despite attempts to improve work, incompetence, misconduct, or insubordination.**

VI. MODE OF APPLICATION

- (a) Qualified candidates should submit their application on the prescribed Application Form which may be obtained at the Reception Desk, Mauritius Sports Council, Royal Road, Belle Rose, or on our website <http://www.mauritiussportscouncil.com/English/Pages/Vacancies.aspx>.
- (b) Applications should reach the Human Resource Officer, Mauritius Sports Council, Royal Road, Belle Rose through registered post 30 March 2026 **not later than 2026**
- (c) Applications not made on the prescribed form will not be accepted.
- (d) Envelopes should be clearly marked on the top left-hand corner "**SESSIONAL LIFEGUARD**."

Important

- (i) Incomplete, inadequate or inaccurate filling of the Application Form may cause a candidate's elimination. It is an offence to give information which is false or to conceal any relevant information. This may lead to an application being rejected or, if a candidate has already been appointed, to the termination of his appointment.
- (ii) Qualifications obtained after the closing date for the submission of applications as specified in the advertisement will not be accepted.
- (iii) Only qualified persons should apply.
- (iv) The originals of Birth and Educational certificates should be submitted with the application, but applicants should produce these if and when called upon to do so.
- (v) Only the best qualified candidates will be called for interview.
