**SESSIONAL**

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered as **'SESSIONAL SWIMMING TEACHER for LEARN TO SWIM PROGRAMME** by the Mauritius Sports Council, a statutory body under the aegis of the Ministry of Youth and Sports.

**II. AGE LIMIT**

Candidates should not have reached their **65<sup>th</sup> birthday** by the closing date for the submission of applications.

**III. REQUIRED QUALIFICATION**

- A. A minimum Certificate in Primary Education.**
- B. A qualification in Life Saving from the Royal Life Saving Society or any other recognized institution.**
- C. Level 1 Certificate in Sports Coaching with specialization in swimming awarded by a recognized institution or having a swimming background/ professional swimmer or swimming teacher certificate delivered by any recognized institution.**
- D. Valid first aid with CPR certification**

**Candidates should have:**

- i. Methodical with good organisational skills.
- ii. Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- iii. Customer-focused and outgoing personality.
- iv. Willingness to work according to flexible schedule.
- v. Ability to work under pressure
- vi. Good physical fitness level.
- vii. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with others.
- viii. Effective use of discretion to solve problem in a fast-paced environment.
- ix. A clean character certificate.
- x. Selected candidates are expected to pass a practical test and a physical fitness test.

**IV. DUTIES**

- 1)** To teach swimming across all levels of programs from Youth, Beginner, Adult, elderlies.
- 2)** Attend workshops and meetings delivered by the council.
- 3)** Actively and positively promotes the sport of swimming.
- 4)** Help teach people of all ages and abilities to develop swimming skills, technique, and confidence in the water.
- 5)** Continuously stay up to date with current health and safety standards, and maintain a current first aid or lifeguard certification.
- 6)** Responsible for preventing injuries by minimizing or eliminating hazardous situations and potential dangers before they happen

## NOTE

- Upon selection, candidates will be required to submit a character certificate.
- Upon selection candidates not possessing a valid First aid with CPR certification will need go through the training at their own cost.
- A contract may be terminated at any time in the event of poor performance despite attempts to improve work, incompetence, misconduct, or insubordination.

## VI. MODE OF APPLICATION

- (a) Qualified candidates should submit their application on the prescribed Application Form which may be obtained at the Reception Desk, Mauritius Sports Council, Royal Road, Belle Rose, or on our website <http://www.mauritiussportscouncil.com/English/Pages/Vacancies.aspx>.
- (b) Applications should reach the Human Resource Executive, Mauritius Sports Council, Royal Road, Belle Rose through registered post **not later than 30 March 2026**.
- (c) Applications not made on the prescribed form will not be accepted.
- (d) Envelopes should be clearly marked on the top left-hand corner "**SESSIONAL SWIMMING TEACHER**."

## Important

- (i) Incomplete, inadequate or inaccurate filling of the Application Form may cause a candidate's elimination. It is an offence to give information which is false or to conceal any relevant information. This may lead to an application being rejected or, if a candidate has already been appointed, to the termination of his appointment.
- (ii) Qualifications obtained after the closing date for the submission of applications as specified in the advertisement will not be accepted.
- (iii) Only qualified persons should apply.
- (iv) The originals of Birth and Educational certificates should be submitted with the application, but applicants should produce these if and when called upon to do so.
- (v) Only the best qualified candidates will be called for interview.
